An act to require all major highway intersections and interstates to have transverse rumble strips in Kentucky.

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: Presently in the Commonwealth of Kentucky, only a few highway intersections have transverse rumble strips. We want all Kentucky major highway intersections and interstates to have transverse rumble strips.

Section 2: Transverse rumble strips is an enforcement that states: each and every major highway and intersections new or old, will be required to have transverse rumble strips. The Kentucky Department of Transportation will identify which intersections will received transverse rumble strips. The Federal Highway Administration will enforce which highways will install the transverse rumble strips.

Section 3: According to the Federal Highway Administration, this will cost ten cents per linear foot. The money will be withdrawn from the Federal Highway Administration's budget, which they get from taxes.

Section 4: This bill will go into effect January 1st the year after it has passed.
