1 2 3	An act to Title: An act to require protective equipment for all youth baseball and softball pitchers in the state of Kentucky.
4	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

6 7 8	Section 1: All pitchers involved in youth baseball and softball will be required to wear protective equipment while participating in both practices and games.
8 9 10 11	Section 2: Any child 18 and under or still enrolled in high school is required to wear the protective equipment.
12 13 14	Section 3: The protective equipment will consist of: baseball hats and chest protectors for boys and face masks and chest protectors for girls.
15 16	Section 4: Requirements for equipment will be the following:
17 18 19 20	* Chest protectors must be a separate shirt with built-in pad for chest * Full-wired face mask that includes a pad on the forehead and chin * Padded hat liner beneath the baseball hat
21 22 23	Section 5: Coaches, umpires, and/or other officials will be required to check for protective equipment and see that it meets standards during practices and games.
24 25 26	Section 6: If a team is found in violation of the rules, then all practices and games will be suspended until proper equipment is in place.
27 28	Section 7: This bill will be funded by the leagues and schools participating in these athletic events.
29 30	Section 8: This bill will go into effect three months following the passage of the bill, allowing time to raise money and purchase protective equipment.
