- 1 An act to require all police stations to take unwanted, unneeded, expired medicine, and safely dispose of it.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: This bill would required all police stations to take unwanted, unneeded, and expired medicine, and
6 dispose of them safely.
7
8 Section 2: This bill be allow people to dispose of medication they no longer use to their local police station.
9 This bill will require a staff member to be on site during normal business hours and dispose of medication as
10 needed. No funding is necessary for this bill as the site and employees are already on staff.

12 Section 3: The purpose of this bill is to ensure that the people of Kentucky will have a way to properly
13 dispose of unwanted, unneeded, and expired medicine. This should help decrease the amount of prescription
14 drug abuse and drug overdose deaths, as well as the amount of drugs found in our environment.

16 Section 4: This bill will be enforced by the Kentucky Office of Drug Control Policy.
