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1                   An act to provide a community service class for all Kentucky high school students.  
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3                   **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**  
4  
5 Section 1: This bill will provide a new elective for all Kentucky public high schools, required to be taken by all  
6 high school students, entitled "GENERAL COMMUNITY SERVICE", in which students will embark on many  
7 service opportunities that will benefit the community and the school.  
8  
9 Section 2: The class will take up one class period per grade, per day. There will be a maximum of 35 students  
10 in this class per class period. The teacher must be trained as a high school counselor in order to apply for  
11 this position.  
12  
13 Section 3: The Customer Service and Community Relations department of the public school systems will be  
14 placed in charge of enforcing this bill.  
15  
16 Section 4: Title I funds will cover the costs of this bill. The costs involved would be those of hiring one new  
17 teacher for the class; all other projects and/or trips will be funded through the families, the schools, and any  
18 other private investor.  
19  
20 Section 5: Any school not offering the class will be warned and asked to offer the class within two weeks of  
21 that date. If the class is still not offered then, the school will be fined \$5,000 and asked to offer the class. A  
22 new \$5,000 fine will be demanded every two weeks the class is not offered by the school.  
23  
24 Section 6: This bill will go into effect on the first school day for the 2015-2016 school year.
