1 An act to restore Kentucky’s environments by focusing on littering laws.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: 17%of Kentucky’s households do not participate in trash collection. This problem has led to
6 Kentucky’s interstates suffering to a littering problem. Garbage lines our major interstates causing many
7 negative environmental effects.

9 If this bill is passed it will require thirty monitored highway cameras to be placed at different mile markers on
10 popular traveled and heavily littered Kentucky interstate highways to observe and eventually control the
11 litter.

13 Section 2: The environment and wildlife is important part of Kentucky. 47% percent of Kentucky is covered in
14 forest. The state is also home to thirty-seven endangered animal species. This bill will help create a better
15 environment for those animals to live and roam for many years to come.

17 Section 3: The litter will be cleaned by inmates as well as people sentenced to community service. The
18 highway camera footage will be monitored by the Kentucky State Police department.

20 Section 4: The camera used will be the Brinno Bcc100 Hd time-lapse construction camera bundle. The price
21 of the cameras is \$269.99. If this bill is passed it would cost \$8099.70 for all thirty cameras which will be
22 installed by the Kentucky State Police.
