5	Section 1: In the Commonwealth of the State of Kentucky, registered voters are not required to present any
6	form of formal identification when voting. This caters to those who persuade others to vote illegally under
7	another person's name.

10	includes fake registrations with made-up names; "ghost" voting by the dearly departed; elderly voters having
