- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

- 5 Section 1: This bill will require the Kentucky Department of Transportation to install guardrails on all
- 6 Kentucky highways that are deemed to have severe or hazardous conditions/areas.
- 7
- 8 Section 2: Funding for this bill will come from the funds allocated to the Kentucky Department of
- 9 Transportation by the state and federal governments.
- 10
- 11 Section 3: The Kentucky Department of Transportation and the Transportation Departments of each county
- 12 will be responsible for the implementation of this bill.
- 13
- 14 Section 4: This bill will go into effect February of 2015.
