1 An act to require that all law enforcement must obtain a warrant before using drones in a place where
2 individual have an expectation of privacy.

4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

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6 Section 1: This bill requires all law enforcement personnel to obtain a warrant before using a drone to spy on
7 someone when they should have reasonable expectation of privacy
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9 Section 2: This bill will cost \$0

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11 Section 3: This bill will be enforced by the Kentucky State Police (KSP).
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13 Section 4: Failure to abide by this law will result in the following:

14 First offense- Any evidence procured in this way would be inadmissible in court.

15 Second offense- Loss of ability to use drones for one (1) year and all personnel associated with
16 drone must undergo appropriate usage training.

17 Third offense- The department may be charged with harassment and invasion of privacy.
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19 Section 5: All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this bill are hereby repealed.

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21 Section 6: This bill will go into effect ninety (90) days after the passage and signature by the governor.
