- 1 An act to require law enforcement with access to military-grade weapons to receive military-grade training

- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: In 1991 Congress passed the National Defense Authorization Act, which gives the Pentagon the
- 6 authority to give excess military weapons to police forces throughout the country. In response to the events
- 7 earlier this year in Ferguson, Missouri our bill requires all police officers to receive military grade training in
- 8 how to use military grade weapons if these weapons were made available to them by the Pentagon.

- 10 Section 2: The police officers in the Commonwealth of Kentucky who have access to military grade weapons
- 11 will receive their required training from officers or other certified trainers who preside at the military base in
- 12 Ft. Knox, Kentucky.

- 14 Section 3: The funding for this bill will come from the State Department of Police’s annual budget.
- 15
- 16 Section 4: Failure to complete this additional safety training if access to military grade weapons is provided
- 17 will result in immediate expulsion from the police force. The responsibility for ensuring proper training is
- 18 completed by all officers’ applicable falls to the individual Department local branch.

- 20 Section 5: This bill will go into effect upon passage.
