1 An act to require that all citizens in the state of Kentucky that are receiving welfare benefits from the  
2 government, be subject to random drug testing.

3  
4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5  
6 Section 1: This bill will require all Kentucky residents who are receiving welfare benefits to be randomly drug  
7 tested.

8  
9 Section 2: The recipients who are selected to be randomly drug tested must report to their local health  
10 department within two days of receiving notification.

11  
12 Section 3: The recipients who are randomly selected will be tested for illegal drugs or non-prescribed  
13 medications.

14  
15 Section 4: Violations for finding drugs in urine sample.  
16 1st offense- 50% cut in welfare benefits for one pay period.  
17 2nd offense- Suspension from all benefits for one month and attend drug counseling.  
18 3rd offense- They will not receive any benefits until clean drug test.

19  
20 Section 5: This bill will not affect citizens who are receiving benefits from the Social Security Disability  
21 Program.

22  
23 Section 6: Funding for drug tests will be provided by the Kentucky Cabinet for Health and Family Services.  
24 Any recovery money that results from this law will also help to fund this program.

25  
26 Section 7: Upon passage this bill will become law on June 1, 2015.
