1 An act to allow the use therapeutic drugs for the treatment of sex offenders.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: Currently Sexual offenders have an enormously high re-offense rate of 37% in our state. It's
6 glaringly apparent that something innovative must be done to solve this problem. Therapeutic drugs are
7 innovative and can be a very effective way to reduce re-offense rates
8
9 Section 2: Allow state recognized psychiatrists to prescribe chemical castration for the treatment of sexual
10 offenders.

12 Section 3: Allow the prescription of chemical castration by state recognized psychiatrist for the treatment of
13 sexual offenders to be part of parole agreements.

15 Section 4: This bill would not have any cost as the sexual offenders would pay for the drugs themselves.

17 Section 5: This bill would take effect on January 1, 2015.
