3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: According to The Kentucky Teen Pregnancy Coalition in 2010 alone there were 6,749 teenage
6 births in Kentucky.
7
8 Section 2: Current National Health Education Standards adopted for Kentucky require instruction on the
9 impact of sexual decisions.
10
11 Section 3: Therefore, all high school students in Kentucky will be required to take an in depth sexual
12 education class.
13
14 Section 4: Sex education will include the topics of STD's, pregnancy, contraceptives, human development,
15 sexual identity, masturbation, and sexual orientation.
16
17 Section 5: School districts in Kentucky would provide direct educative support to teenage mothers.
18
19 Section 6: This bill will be in effect July 1, 2016.
