6	every two years while state Senators run every 4 years, with 19 of the 38 running every two years.

8 9	Section 2: All state legislators will be bound to an 8 year limit, with Representatives limited to 4 terms and Senators limited to 2 terms.

11	Section 3: This bill would combat a passive political agenda and would assist the fight in limiting corrupt
