1	An act to extend voting hours in the state of Kentucky.
2	
3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
4	
5	Section 1: The current voting hours for registered voters in Kentucky are 6am–6pm. With the passage of
6	this bill, the voting hours in Kentucky will be extended from 6pm to 8pm.
7	
8	Section 2: This bill will in no way change poll location or voter registration.
9	
10	Section 3: This bill will have no cost. Kentucky precinct election officers (the people who work the polls) are
11	paid a minimum of \$70 for service: \$10 minimum for mandatory training and \$60 minimum per Election Day.
12	With the passage of this bill, the pay for these workers will not change, they will just be required to work 2
13	extra hours.
14	

15 Section 4: This bill will go into effect for the next Kentucky election.
