8	Section 2: For Kentucky citizens between the ages of 18 and 21 to be eligible to legally purchase and
9	consume alcoholic beverages, citizens between the ages of 18 to 21 must:

11	A) Fill out a registration form at the county clerks office in which they reside

13	B) Citizens must provide an official copy of their high school diploma/G.E.D

15	C) Once conditions A and B are met for Section 2, the county clerks office will provide a state issued sticker
16	to be placed on the recipients drivers license. Kentucky citizens between the ages of 18 and 21 will be
17	eligible to purchase and consume alcoholic beverages in the state of Kentucky

19	Section 3: If Section 1 and Section 2 are not followed, citizens will not be eligible to purchase or consume
