1 An act to lower the legal age to purchase and consume alcoholic beverages from age 21 to age 18.

2  
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: All Kentucky citizens over the age of 18 who have graduated from high school, or have obtained  
6 their G.E.D will be eligible to purchase and consume alcoholic beverages in the state of Kentucky

8 Section 2: For Kentucky citizens between the ages of 18 and 21 to be eligible to legally purchase and  
9 consume alcoholic beverages, citizens between the ages of 18 to 21 must:

10 A) Fill out a registration form at the county clerks office in which they reside

11 B) Citizens must provide an official copy of their high school diploma/G.E.D

12 C) Once conditions A and B are met for Section 2, the county clerks office will provide a state issued sticker  
13 to be placed on the recipients drivers license. Kentucky citizens between the ages of 18 and 21 will be  
14 eligible to purchase and consume alcoholic beverages in the state of Kentucky

15 Section 3: If Section 1 and Section 2 are not followed, citizens will not be eligible to purchase or consume  
16 alcoholic beverages until the age of 21

17 Section 4: Employers/employees selling or distributing alcoholic beverages are still required to be at least 21  
18 years of age

19 Section 5: This bill will go into effect on January 1st, 2015
