Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

6 Section 1: This bill would ban the sale, transport and human consumption of horse meat for within the
7 Kentucky.

Section 2: Horse and other equines are domestic animals that are used primarily for recreation, pleasure, and
sport. Equines raise in the United States and elsewhere are frequently treated with drugs, including
phenylbutazone, acepromazine, boldenone undecylenate, omeprazole, ketoprofen, xylazine, hyaluronic acid,
etc. None of these drugs approved for use on horses are intended for human consumption. Consuming parts
of an equine, likely poses a serious threat to human health and the public should be protected from these
unsafe products.

Section 3: The sale or transport of equines within the borders of Kentucky, by any person or persons that
knows of or reasonably should have known that such equines are intended to be slaughtered for human
consumption shall be prohibited. The sale or transport of equine parts (including flesh, meat and viscera)
within the borders of Kentucky, by any person or persons that knows of or reasonable should have known
that such equine parts are intended for human consumption shall be prohibited.

Section 4: This prohibition shall be enforced by the Food and Drug Administration.
