1	An act to require all Kentucky public high schools to begin the school day at 8:15 AM.

3 4	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
5 6 7 8 9	Section 1: This bill will mandate the start time for all Kentucky public high schools. A later start time will improve student academic performance in class and on standardized tests, and it will also decrease behavior problems in school. School will begin at 8:15 AM consistent with the time zone of the region the school is located.
10 11 12 13	Section 2: Bus routes and routines will be unaffected with the exception of the later start time. In order to avoid transportation conflicts, elementary schools will be required to begin the school day at least one half hour prior to 8:15 AM. Middle school start time will be determined by the school board.
14 15 16 17 18	Section 3: The Kentucky Department of Education will enforce this bill. Schools that do not abide by the bill will be placed on probation by the Kentucky Department of Education. State funding to the school will be reduced by 10% in the instance that observed student performance levels fall below benchmark requirements of the state.
19 20	Section 4:This bill will require no additional funding.
21	Section 5: This bill will be enacted at the start of the 2016–2017 school year.
