1                   An Act to Amend KRS 211-755 in Order To Protect The Rights of Breastfeeding Women  
2  
3                   **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**  
4  
5 Section 1: This bill is an act to amend KRS 211-755; Keep current provisions except remove the clause  
6 "notwithstanding any other provision of the law". Specifically, that breastfeeding and expressing milk shall be  
7 permitted in any location the mother and child are otherwise authorized. Discrimination against  
8 breastfeeding is a form of sex discrimination. Breastfeeding and expressing milk shall not be considered a  
9 disruption.  
10  
11 Section 2: This bill is an act to prevent discrimination against breastfeeding women in any location, public or  
12 private, where the mother and child are otherwise authorized.  
13  
14 Section 3: The goal of this amendment is to clarify that discrimination against breastfeeding is a form of sex  
15 discrimination and the sole act of breastfeeding cannot be considered a disturbance.  
16  
17 Section 4: The current wording of Kentucky law allows for business owners to expel breastfeeding mothers  
18 by labeling them as disruptive; thus police officers have removed people for the act of breastfeeding.  
19  
20 Section 5: This law will be enforced by law enforcement officials.  
21  
22 Section 6: If a business is found not in compliance, they will be fined \$100.00 every time that they violate  
23 this law. The money collected from the fines will be given to the Kentucky Cabinet for Health and Family  
24 Services.

26 Section 7: This bill will go into effect 3 months after its passage
