1 An act to start community gardens for all Kentucky schools.
2

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
4

5 Section 1: The garden must be located on school property, in a location such as a courtyard or vacant area
6 away from the normal paths of students.
7

8 Section 2: Seeds, plants, fertilizer, and any other garden materials will be donated from local farmers and
9 local farm stores. Businesses that donate will be eligible for tax-deductible credits
10

11 Section 3: Local farmers, members of the FFA, and members of 4-H will work with high school students to
12 teach the basics of growing produce.
13

14 Section 4: Food from the school's garden will be integrated into the school's lunch program. Any additional
15 produce not used by for the school's lunch program will be donated to local food banks.
16

17 Section 5: This bill will meet the Let's Move, HealthierUS School Challenge: Smarter Lunchrooms, issued in
18 2010 by First Lady Michelle Obama.
19

20 Section 6: This bill will go into effect spring, 2015.
