1 An act to require the installation of one fire extinguisher per K-12 classroom in Kentucky,
2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
4
5 Section 1: Teachers will now be able to defend themselves and their class, in case of an intruder, without any
6 lethal weapons. Also by requiring a fire extinguisher to be installed in each classroom, it will be easier and
7 more time efficient to extinguish a fire anywhere in the building.
8
9 Section 2: The cost for one fire extinguisher would be \$60 per extinguisher when bought in bulk of 50.
10 Extinguishers will be in a secure location within close proximity to the teachers work area.
11
12 Section 3: Koorsen Fire and Security provides two separate training sessions explaining the proper
13 techniques for extinguisher usage. Sessions are free to schools, and consist of 1.5 hour long classes that will
14 enable teachers to safely and effectively use the extinguishers in the case of an emergency.

16 Section 4: This will be paid for with the school's budget. If any cuts have to be made, it will be up to the
17 school board.
18
19 Section 5: This bill will go into effect at the beginning of the 2015/16 school year after date of passage.
