1 An act to require Blood Typing on Drivers' Licenses.

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3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

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5 Section 1: This act requires for each citizens blood type to be listed on their drivers license, and/or permit.

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7 Section 2: The blood type listing gives important information to medical professionals about the patient
8 needing blood, in the case that they are not able to communicate.

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10 Section 3: Citizens will be administered a blood type test as part of a regular physical or "check-up" to
11 determine their blood type.

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13 Section 4: In the case that this testing would cost money, the license holder would be responsible for any
14 additional cost.

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16 Section 5: The information about a citizen's blood type will then be transferred to their license.

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18 Section 6: This act will go into effect January 1st, 2015 with the renewal of, or new license.
