1 An act to require welfare recipients to be given jobs based on their specific abilities.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: This bill will boost our economy and provide more jobs for the general population.
6
7 Section 2: We believe that our bill will change the current politics of the welfare program for the better.
8
9 Section 3: This bill will effect all citizens who receive welfare and all people who apply for welfare in the
10 future.

12 Section 4: This bill will establish a government sanctioned placement facility specifically for people who
13 receive welfare benefits, and allow them to give back to the communities in which they live.

15 Section 5: The recipients will treat this job as if it were a normal job. All rules will apply such as reduced pay,
16 promotions, demotions, and they can be fired from the job previously provided to them, and made to find a
17 new one.

19 Section 6: This bill will require a sizable initial investment, but overtime, this money will be earned back
20 through improvements to the economy that this program will provide.

22 Section 7: This bill will be enacted in two parts. This first, which is the creation of jobs, will take effect
23 immediately after passage. The second phase, which is the actual job placement process, will take effect as
24 jobs are created.
