- An act to set aside land in Fort Knox for wounded veterans: "Hunting With Heroes". 1 2 3 Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky 4 5 6 7 Section 1: This bill will allow our wounded warriors who may have trouble living in normal society again, and any other veterans to enjoy outdoor activities such as hunting, fishing, and archery...with the aid of volunteers if they need assistance. 8 9 Section 2: Nearly 250,338 veterans have adjustment problems when coming back from the armed forces. 10 The program created by our bill would help them to adjust more easily to society in a way that they can 11 enjoy and will provide them with aid in doing so. 12 13 Section 3: This bill will set aside a portion of Fort Knox for those veterans who would like to participate in 14 activities outdoors, but can't due to a wound or disability. This will take volunteers to go through a short 15 training. 16 17 Section 4: The organization will be non-profit and will be founded by government, as well as donations for 18 equipment, training, and handicap accommodations. 19
- 20 Sections 5: This bill will go into effect 6 months after passage.
