- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: This bill will require that teen drivers ages 16-18 will place stickers on their vehicles.
- 6
- 7 Section 2: A fee of two dollars will be added to the permit cost. This will make the cost to obtain a permit
- 8 \$15.00 and will cover the cost of the sticker.
- 9
- 10 Section 3: This bill will effect teens applying for permits and up to age 18.
- 11
- 12 Section 4: The bill will go into effect January 1, 2015.
