1 An act to require that all persons who reach the age of 70 retake the driver's license test.
2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: Presently in the state of Kentucky, people are only required to take their driving test once in their
6 lifetime. About 593 accidents have occurred in Kentucky in the past five (5) years. Many elderly people are
7 still allowed to drive despite possible disabilities. If people over the age of seventy (70) retake their driving
8 test, then the number of accidents will be reduced each year.

10 Section 2: Once any person reaches the age of seventy (70), he or she will be required to retake the driving
11 test in their county of residence. The driving test can be taken up to six (6) times, with a one week waiting
12 period between each re-administration. If the driving test is still not passed after the sixth attempt, then the
13 person must wait a year before another attempt.

15 Section 3: Any person reaching the age of seventy (70) must take the full test excluding the preliminary
16 permits and temporary licenses. Once the person passes the test, they will be reissued their full license. The
17 driver will then pay the regular fees for renewing a license.

19 Section 4: This bill will be in effect on June 1, 2015.
