- 1 An act to require that all Kentucky students in grades 6-12 receive a suicide prevention class.
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- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
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- 5 Section 1: All students in grades 6-12 must receive a suicide prevention class.
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- 7 Section 2: The suicide class will be an added unit to the students' original science curriculum. The unit will be
- 8 taught by the science teacher.
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- 10 Section 3: At the end of the unit, the students will be tested on the information. The results will be sent to
- 11 the Kentucky Department of Education for evaluation.

- 13 Section 4: If a school refuses to comply with this law, the consequences will be as follows:
- 14 1st offence- \$100.00 fine to the school
- 15 2nd offence- \$150.00 fine to the school, and the science teacher will be suspended for 1 week.
- 16 3rd offence- \$200.00 fine to the school, and the science teacher will be suspended 3 weeks.

- 18 Section 5: This law will go into effect at the beginning of the 2015-2016 school year.
