An act to make Death with Dignity legal.

Section 1: This bill is to legalize doctors helping in assisted suicide. Currently, this procedure is illegal in the state of Kentucky.

Section 2: There is no money needed to enact this bill. The money saved from enforcing the current law would go back to the state. Court costs and costs of medication would be paid by anyone who would take advantage of this medical procedure.

Section 3: This procedure is only to be performed under the supervision of a doctor, only after it has gone through court. Anyone who doesn't follow this procedure would be penalized under the current law.

Section 4: This bill will be enacted on December 31, 2015.
