1 An act to promote safety among unsafe and elderly drivers.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: Drivers age 70 and over must renew their drivers licenses every two years instead of the usual
6 four in the state of Kentucky.

7

8 Section 2: All drivers, regardless of age, must renew their license in person rather than by mail.

9

10 Section 3: If the driver is physically unable to renew their license in person, the driver must send a letter
11 explaining why they could not be present containing a doctor's note stating that they are fit to drive and
12 results of an eye test.

14 Section 4: Every driver, regardless of age must pass an eye exam when they renew their license, and staff
15 can require anyone to take a written or road test if they suspect mental or physical impairments that may
16 affect driving.

18 Section 5: Law enforcement, family members, doctors, neighbors, or bystanders may confidentially report
19 suspected unsafe drivers. If this happens, the unsafe driver is required to see a physician and eye doctor and
20 take a driving test. If the driver does not pass the test, there could be limits set on the driver's license such
21 as driving only in daylight.

23 Section 6: This bill will go into effect on July 1, 2015.
