1	An act to require any person receiving a driving permit to take a TLSAE course.
2	
3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
4	
5	Section 1: All people receiving their driver's license must complete a Traffic Law and Substance Abuse
6 7	Education course (TLSAE).
8	Section 2: The TLSAE course is a four hour online course that educates people on alcohol and drug abuse
9	and various traffic laws. If any individual does not have access to a computer, a public may be used.
10	
11	Section 3: After the course is completed, a 40 question exam must be passed. The results will be
12	electronically sent to the Kentucky Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV). Everyone will have three attempts
13	to pass the final exam. If the exam is failed all three times, the computer must be reset for three more
14	attempts.
15 16	Section 4: The Kentucky Department of Motor Vehicles (DMV) will enforce this bill.
17	Section 4: The Kentucky Department of Motor Venicles (DMV) will enforce this bill.
18	Section 5: The cost to take the course is \$19.00. A fee of \$15.00 must be paid if the final exam has to be
19	reset for three more attempts.
20	
21	section 6: Failure to abide by this law will result in the individual's license being withheld until the course if
22	completed with a passing grade of 80% or higher or scoring 32 out of 40 questions.
23	
24	Section 7: All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this bill are hereby repealed.
25	

26 Section 8: This law will go into effect 90 days after passage and with the signature of the Governor.
