- 1 An act to require all K-12 schools' faculty, staff, and volunteers to be first aid trained.

- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: All faculty and staff in K-12 schools are required to have up to date certification in first aid, CPR,
- 6 and blood borne pathogens.
- 7
- 8 Section 2: Training and certification must be done in conjunction with the Red Cross or other agencies that
- 9 have equal standards.
- 10
- 11 Section 3: Payment for training is at the discretion of the school.
- 12
- 13 Section 4: All sporting events and practices are required to have a certified athletic trainer present.
- 14
- 15 Section 5: This bill will go into effect on August 15, 2015.
