1 An act to Regulate the Act of Riding in the Back of a Pick-up Truck in Kentucky.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: Kentucky currently does not have a law against people riding in the back of a pick-up truck.

6
7 Section 2: This law will ensure that no person shall ride in the back of a pick-up truck on roads where the
8 speed limit is 55 miles per hour or over.

10 Section 3: Excluded from this bill:
11 • Life threatening emergencies

12
13 Section 4: When enacted, the State of Kentucky will incur minor expenses. The revenue from the penalties
14 will cover these minor costs.

16 Section 5: Penalties:
17 • 1st Offense- driver is ticketed and charged a \$25 fee
18 • 2nd Offense any beyond- driver is ticketed and charged a \$50 fee

19
20 Section 6: Upon passage, this bill will go into effect January 1, 2015.
