An act to require all Kentucky citizens receiving disability benefits to complete a physical and/or mental health screening annually.

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: Adult recipients of disability are granted benefits if they are unable to work due to a physical or mental health impairment that has or is expected to last for at least 12 months. There are over 180,000 Kentucky residents who receive disability benefits; the state spends over \$1 billion on disability benefits annually.

Section 2: In order to reduce the amount of money spent on disability benefits, there should be annual mental and/or physical evaluations for all recipients. This policy will ensure that all disability recipients are genuine and in need of the support from the state.

Section 3: All disability recipients will receive adequate notice of the date of their health screening. Any disability recipient who does not complete their screening by the designated date will pay the following fines:

- 5% of benefits will be deducted after 30 days
- 10% of benefits will be deducted after 60 days
- All benefits will be revoked after 90 days

Section 4: Kentucky Cabinet for Health and Family Services will be in charge of enforcing this law, as funding for disability comes from the Social Security tax and is finalized through this department.

Section 5: This bill will go into effect January 1, 2016.
