An act to enforce substitute teacher requirements.

Section 1:
This bill is to require substitutes to have the following:

- At least a 3.0 GPA
- Bachelor’s degree
- In addition to bachelor’s degree must also have at least 64 hours of dealing with children in an educational setting.

Section 2: Currently in Kentucky, substitutes are only required to have at least 64 hours of college credits with only a 2.45 GPA (at least). They also have to apply and receive a one year substitute certification.

Section 3: In addition to the requirements listed in section 1, we feel that substitutes pay needs to be increased. Substitutes in Kentucky currently get paid \$77 per day. We will raise the pay to \$100 per day.

Section 4: Because of the increase of substitutes paychecks, there will be extra funding needed. The property tax will be raised from 12.2 cents to 13 cents per \$100. Each person will only have to pay an average of \$23 extra a year.

Section 5: This bill will go into effect 1 year upon the approval date.
