An act to grade public restrooms in Kentucky.

Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

Section 1: A health inspector will travel to public restrooms (rest stops, gas station, hospitals, and public shopping centers.) The inspector will provide a letter grade (A-F) for the health evaluation of the restroom. If the establishment fails the evaluation they are required to put forth a percentage of profit for cleanliness for their restrooms. Just like the inspections of restaurants, the grade will be posted in local newspapers.

Section 2: If the establishment receives a letter grade C or below they will provide 2% of monthly profit. This money will go toward the total price of the equipment needed to evaluate the bathroom, and the cleaning of their restrooms.

Section 3: The health inspectors that evaluate restaurants, will go to the most common restrooms. They will grade the restrooms in the same fashion as the restaurant grading scale, and post the letter grades in a common place of the establishment, and the results will be posted in the entryway of the establishment or the entry to the restroom.

Section 4: The bill will go into effect in February 2015
