2 3 4	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
5 6 7	Section 1: This bill will mandate that physicians must type their prescriptions, handwritten prescriptions will not be allowed.
, 8 9	Section 2: This bill will ensure that patients are given the correct prescribed prescriptions because they will be easier to read.
10 11 12	Section 3: The cost of the bill, virtually nothing, will be covered by the doctor and their offices.
13 14	Section 4: The penalty for not following this law will result in the following:
15 16	*1st offense = \$100 fine *2nd offense = \$300 fine
17 18 19	*3rd offense = \$500 fine *Each sub sequential offense will result in a \$1000 fine
20 21	Section 5: This law will be enforced by the Kentucky Department of Health.
22 23	Section 6: All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this bill are hereby repealed.
