1 An act to mandate all physicians to type prescriptions or send via internet.
2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
4
5 Section 1: This bill will mandate that physicians must type their prescriptions, handwritten prescriptions will
6 not be allowed.
7
8 Section 2: This bill will ensure that patients are given the correct prescribed prescriptions because they will
9 be easier to read.
10
11 Section 3: The cost of the bill, virtually nothing, will be covered by the doctor and their offices.

13 Section 4: The penalty for not following this law will result in the following:
14
15 *1st offense = \$100 fine
16 *2nd offense = \$300 fine
17 *3rd offense = \$500 fine
18 *Each sub sequential offense will result in a \$1000 fine
19
20 Section 5: This law will be enforced by the Kentucky Department of Health.

22 Section 6: All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this bill are hereby repealed.

24 Section 7: This law will go into effect on January 1, 2016.
