1                                   An act to provide a regional busing system to the state of Kentucky.

3                                   **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**  
4  
5   Section 1: The enabling of this bill will provide a regional busing system to the state of Kentucky.  
6  
7   Section 2: The places the regional bus will travel is Frankfort, Lexington, Louisville, Hickman, Hopkinsville,  
8   Owensboro, Bowling Green, Hendersonville, Paducah, Hazard, Pikeville, Covington, Morehead, Burlington,  
9   London, Russellville, and Elizabethtown.

11   Section 3: The bus will stop at stops all consisting of major cities or towns. The bus system will have 5 to 6  
12   buses that will travel the state of Kentucky. There will be a cost to the bus ticket which will range from \$10  
13   to \$25. Depending on how far the rider would like to travel.  
14  
15   Section 4: Funding for this bill will come from the Kentucky Department of Transportation, transportation  
16   tax, and the bus tickets.  
17  
18   Section 5: If this law is broken there will be a fine of \$500 each day they don't provide regional  
19   transportation.  
20  
21   Section 6: The Kentucky Department of Transportation will enforce this bill.

23   Section 7: All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this bill are hereby repealed.

25   Section 8: This law will go into effect on January 1, 2016.
