- 1 An act to provide economic stimulus promoting economic development to the Eastern Kentucky Coal Region.

- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
- 4
- 5 Section 1: This act would establish a task force to look at economic problems, such as unemployment in the
- 6 Eastern Kentucky Coal field region and develop solutions that would help the dwindling jobs in the coal
- 7 industry.

- 9 Section 2: A panel will be created from leaders in business, labor and environmental planning will develop a
- 10 plan to evaluate and make recommendations for attracting business, training workers and providing
- 11 economic assistance to people in the Eastern Kentucky Coal Region.

- 13 Section 3: Funding will be provided by existing funds in the Department of Economic Development, Federal
- 14 Grants for Economic Relief and private donations. The Department of Economic Development and Office of
- 15 Vocational Rehabilitation will be in charge of implementing and enforcing.

- 17 Section 4: This act will go into effect July 1, 2015.
