1	An act to provide for the requirement of all motorcyclists to wear a helmet.
2	
3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
4	
5	Section 1: The purpose of this bill is to amend the current helmet law to be a universal helmet law, insuring
6	that all persons wear a helmet while riding a motorcycle.
/	Section 3 of KRS 189.285 is amended to read as follows:
8 9	(2) All persons shall be required to wear protective beadgear in the manner proscribed by the secretary of
10	(3) All persons shall be required to wear protective headgear, in the manner prescribed by the secretary of the Transportation Cabinet, at all times the motorcycle or a side car attachment in which they are riding are
11	in motion on a public highway
12	
13	Section 2: Any additional costs incurred by enforcement of this amendment, shall be recouped by fines on
14	motorcyclists in violation of this law.
15	
16	Section 3: The current fines that are in place for violation of KRS 189.285 will remain in place and will apply
17	to violations of the proposed amended law.
18	
19	Section 4: This bill will go into effect 90 days after passage.
