1 An act to require all drivers to retest for driver's license after three assessable accidents over the course of  
2 two years, excluding road debris and nature.  
3

4 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

6 Section 1: The purpose of this bill is to reduce wrecks, fatalities, and to keep roads safer.  
7

8 Section 2: Local law enforcement agencies will enforce this law when an assessable traffic accident occurs.  
9

10 Section 3: After three assessable accidents, the Kentucky Department of Transportation will notify the  
11 individual that his/her license has been suspended and will remain suspended until the driver's test has been  
12 re-taken and passed.  
13

14 Section 4: This bill will not require additional funding.  
15

16 Section 5: If any person is in violation of this law, the following fines will apply:

17 1st Offense: \$200 fine and up to 3 months with a suspended license.

18 2nd Offense: \$400 fine and up to 6 months with a suspended license.

19 3rd Offense: \$600 fine and up to 12 months with a suspended license.  
20

21 Section 6: All money collected from fines will used by the Kentucky Department of Transportation for the use  
22 of promoting and educating drivers about safer roadways in the state of Kentucky.  
23

24 Section 7: This bill will go into effect on June 15, 2016.
