1 An act to require first aid & CPR training for all school bus drivers.
2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

5 Section 1: Currently, there is only one hour of mandatory first aid training required for school bus drivers.
6
7 Section 2: This bill will require all school bus drivers, including sub drivers, to complete first aid & CPR
8 training. All training would be required within the first 30 days of the start of school. Substitute drivers
9 would have 60 days to complete their training. Full-time drivers would be ineligible to drive if they are not
10 trained after 30 days.

12 Section 3: School districts would be responsible for training. Training can be accessed from the Red Cross or
13 local health departments. Transportation directors will show proof of drivers' training to the Kentucky
14 Department of Education. Drivers will be required to re-certify their training every two years.
15
16 Section 4: Upon passage, this bill will take affect in the 2015-2016 school year.
