1	An act to change the common core standards to exclude the requirement of teaching evolution.

3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
4	
5	Section 1: This bill will stop the requirement to teach the theory of evolution. We believe the theory of
6	evolution should not be required to be taught because of the lack of proof. Some people find it offending
7	because they believe in other theories.
8	
9	Section 2: Evolution – 'any process of information or growth; development".
10	
11	Section 3: There will be no punishment for teaching evolution. The Board of Education will decide whether it
12	will be included in each district.
13	
14	Section 4: The Department of Education will be responsible for excluding evolution items on the K-Prep Test
15	
16	Section 5: There will be no cost for this bill.
17	
18	Section 6: This bill will go into effect the 2015–2016 school year.
