- 1 An act to change the common core standards to exclude the requirement of teaching evolution.

- 3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

- 5 Section 1: This bill will stop the requirement to teach the theory of evolution. We believe the theory of
- 6 evolution should not be required to be taught because of the lack of proof. Some people find it offending
- 7 because they believe in other theories.
- 8
- 9 Section 2: Evolution – “any process of information or growth; development”.
- 10
- 11 Section 3: There will be no punishment for teaching evolution. The Board of Education will decide whether it
- 12 will be included in each district.
- 13
- 14 Section 4: The Department of Education will be responsible for excluding evolution items on the K-Prep Test.
- 15
- 16 Section 5: There will be no cost for this bill.
- 17
- 18 Section 6: This bill will go into effect the 2015-2016 school year.
