1           An act to allow individuals under the age of 18 to be exempt from paying state/federal income taxes.  
2  
3                           **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**  
4  
5   Section 1: This bill requires that all employed 15-17 years old, will not have to pay state/federal income  
6   taxes.  
7  
8   Section 2: Paying income taxes and not being able to vote violates the principles of our becoming a new  
9   country in 1776.  
10  
11   Section 3: The Internal Revenue Service will enforce this bill.  
12  
13   Section 4: Consequences for a company:  
14                1st offense: Fine of \$100  
15                2nd offense: Subsequent fine of \$100  
16                3rd offense: Suspension of business for one month  
17                4th offense: Foreclosure of business  
18  
19   Section 5: All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this bill are hereby repealed.  
20  
21   Section 6: This bill will go into effect January 1, 2016, after passage and signature of the Governor.
