1 An act to report an unborn child dying from a mother on illegal drugs.

3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**
4
5 Section 1: This bill will prosecute a mother who has killed her child during pregnancy or birth as a result of
6 using illegal drugs.
7
8 Section 2: The hospital where the mother had the baby will be the enforcer and contact the authorities.
9
10 Section 3: Consequences for the mother (given by the judge):
11 1st offense: Charged with first degree manslaughter with drug counseling and possible parole.
12 2nd offense: Charged will first degree murder with no possible parole in the future.
13
14 Section 4: All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this bill are hereby repealed.
15
16 Section 5: This bill will go into effect on January 1, 2016 after passage and signature of the Governor.
