1	An act to require foreign language courses in middle school.
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3	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky
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5	Section 1: This bill will require all middle schools to have foreign language teachers that are certified to teach
6	foreign education. There will be one certified teacher per middle school that teaches Spanish and French
7	throughout the day for the entire year.
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9	Section 2: This will improve our state by allowing Kentucky to become more interactive with foreigners. We
10	will earn an advantage because of our knowledge of multiple languages.
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12	Section 3: There are 217 middle schools in the state of Kentucky. The average teacher gets paid \$52,552 a
13	year, which breaks down to an average Kentucky teacher getting paid \$292 each instructional day.
14	Kentucky would need \$11,405,520 to pay 217 additional teachers. These funds will be paid by property and
15	car taxes.
16	
17	Section 4: We will use three years to implement 217 teachers that are certified to teach foreign education in

middle schools in Kentucky. This implementation will begin in August of 2017.
