4	Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky

6 7	Section 1: This bill will provide an educational campaign to discourage cigarette butt waste on roadways and other public places.
8	
9	Section 2: This would make the roads and streams much cleaner and healthier. It would also decrease the
10 11	chance of brushfires in Kentucky, making the Commonwealth a cleaner, safer place.
12 13 14	Section 3: Kentucky has the 40th lowest cigarette tax in the country. This bill would raise the cigarette tax by \$.01 per pack which will give us the money needed to fund the program.
15 16 17 18 19	Section 4: Cigarette butts do not decompose, leaving them for wildlife to eat. This can poison them and then decrease our wildlife population. Also, cigarette butts can cause devastating brushfires as well as consuming a large amount of taxes for cleanup and disposal purposes. Cigarette butts pollute the water we drink and animal habitats.
20 21 22	Section 5: This program will be run by the Kentucky Department for Environmental Protection as part of their Waste Management Program.

Section 6: This bill will go into effect one year after its passage.
