1 An act to amend law 189.150 (Prevention of Escaping Contents).

2
3 **Be it enacted by the Youth Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky**

4
5 Section 1: The purpose of this bill is to amend KRS law 189.150 which states: No vehicle shall be operated
6 upon any public highway for a distance of over one mile whose load is susceptible to shifting or spillage
7 unless said load is covered with a device suitable for prevention of spillage.

8
9 Section 2: Currently the maximum fine for failure to cover or secure contents is \$250.

10
11 Section 3: Our bill would be to increase the fine as follows:

12 First offense: \$500 fine and requirement to pay for personal injuries and damages to any vehicle that
13 received property damage due to escaping contents from the perpetrator's vehicle;

14 Second offense: \$800 fine and requirement to pay for personal injuries and property damages to any
15 damaged vehicles;

16 Third offense: \$1000 fine, suspension of CDL license for six months, and also requirement to pay for
17 personal injuries and property damages to any damaged vehicles.

18
19 Section 4: This bill will go in effect April 1, 2015.

20
21 Section 5: All laws or parts of laws in conflict with this bill are hereby considered null and void.
