Section 1: Farmers/Producers may apply to the Kentucky Department of Agriculture for a permit for the growth of industrial hemp.

Section 2: Farmers/Producers who have applied to produce industrial hemp will be required to have a background check by the Kentucky state police.

Section 3: Farmers/Producers who don't pass the background check will not be given a permit to produce.

Section 4: Record keeping and filing requirements will be established.

Section 5: Farmers/Producers will pay a fee for both their background check and permit fee. The fee will be paid to the Department of Agriculture.

Section 6: Upon passage, this bill will become law on July 1, 2015. □
